Concrete repair work

About 150 streets throughout Cupertino are scheduled for paving this year. Prior to paving, any needed concrete work is completed. With miles of improvements, door-to-door notification typically does not occur, however, advance notice is given to residents when access to their driveways may be temporarily impacted. Other work in the City rights-of-way is marked with No Parking signs and barricades. Each year, the city website lists streets scheduled for improvement.
