Dear City Clerk Schmidt:

The initiative petition submitted to our office on February 2, 2016 contained 4,204 signatures. Based on the 26,866 registered voters in the City of Cupertino, as of the February 10, 2015 report of registration to the Secretary of State, the petition needs 2,686 (10%) or 4,029 (15%).

Your jurisdiction requested that the Registrar of Voters examine and verify 100% of the signatures. The Registrar of Voters verified 4,204 of the signatures filed in accordance with Elections Code Section 9114, within 30 days from the date of filing of the petition and from the records of registration ascertain whether or not the petition is signed by the requisite number of voters.

The verification results of 100% of the signatures submitted found 3,759 signatures were valid. Your jurisdiction required 2,686 (10%) or 4,029 (15%), therefore the petition is sufficient.
